

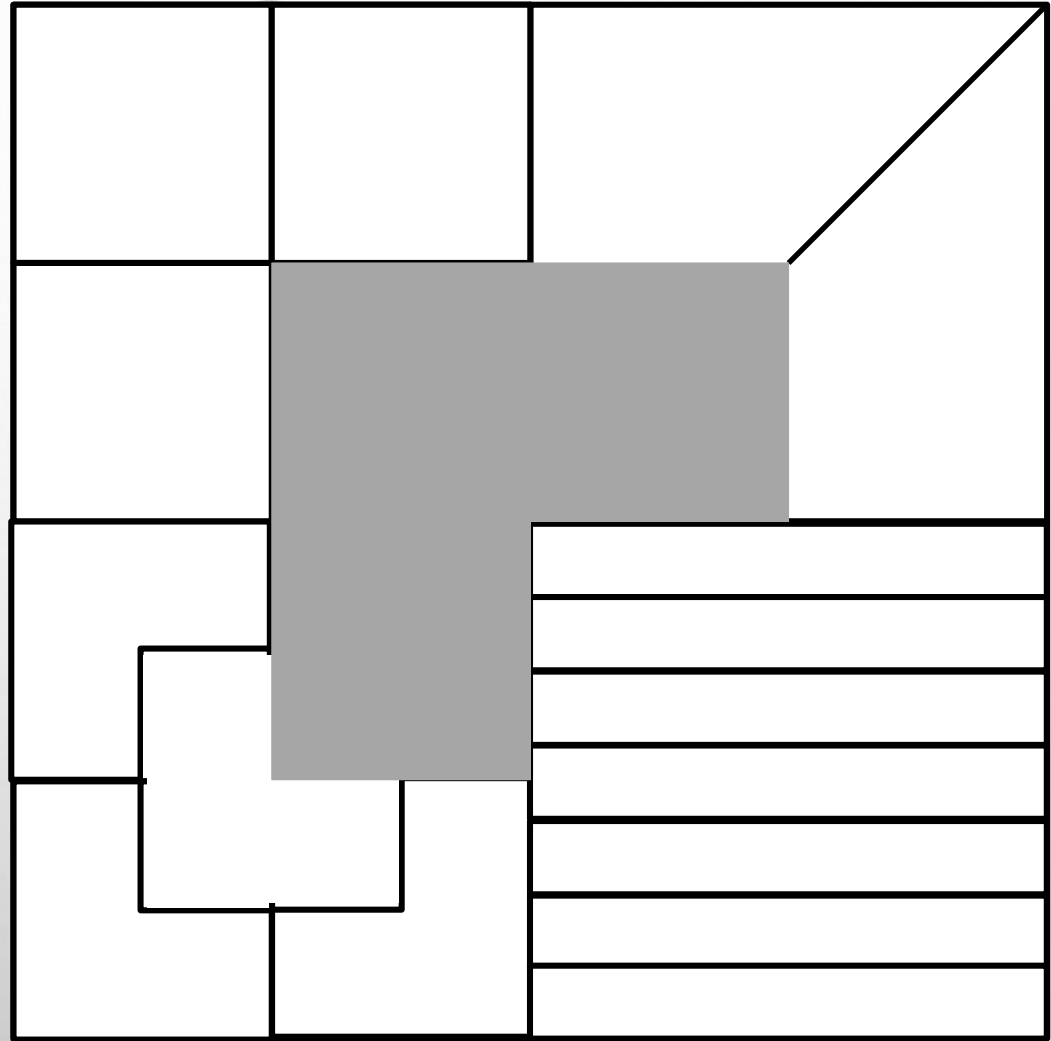

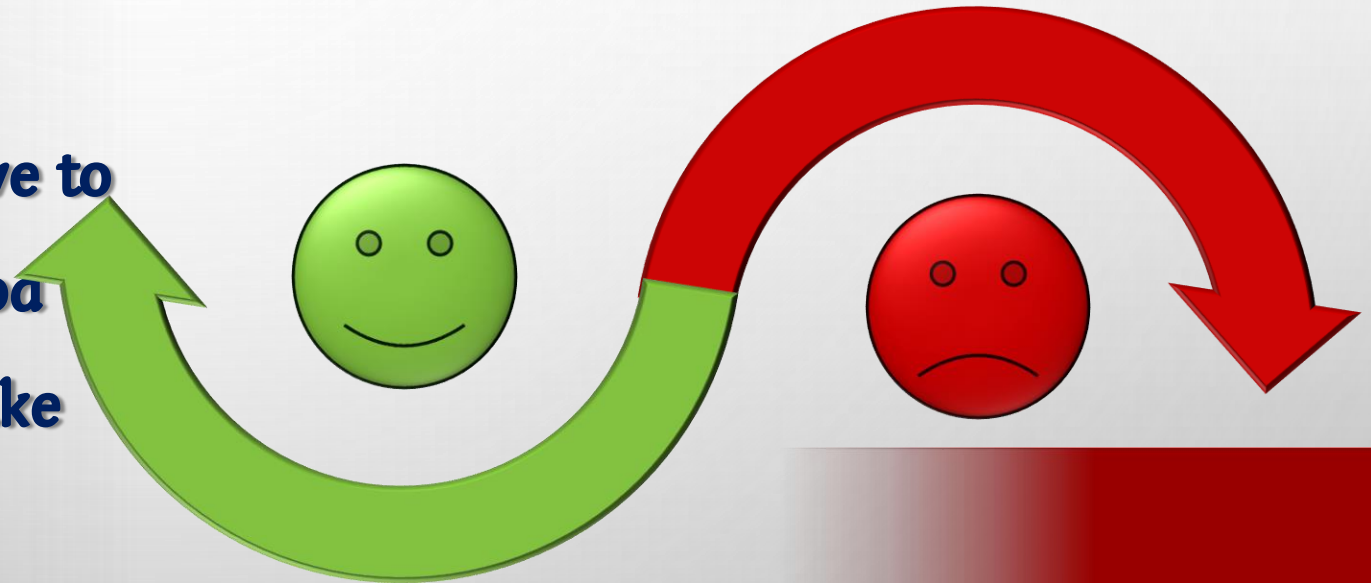

but of power and love and self-control.

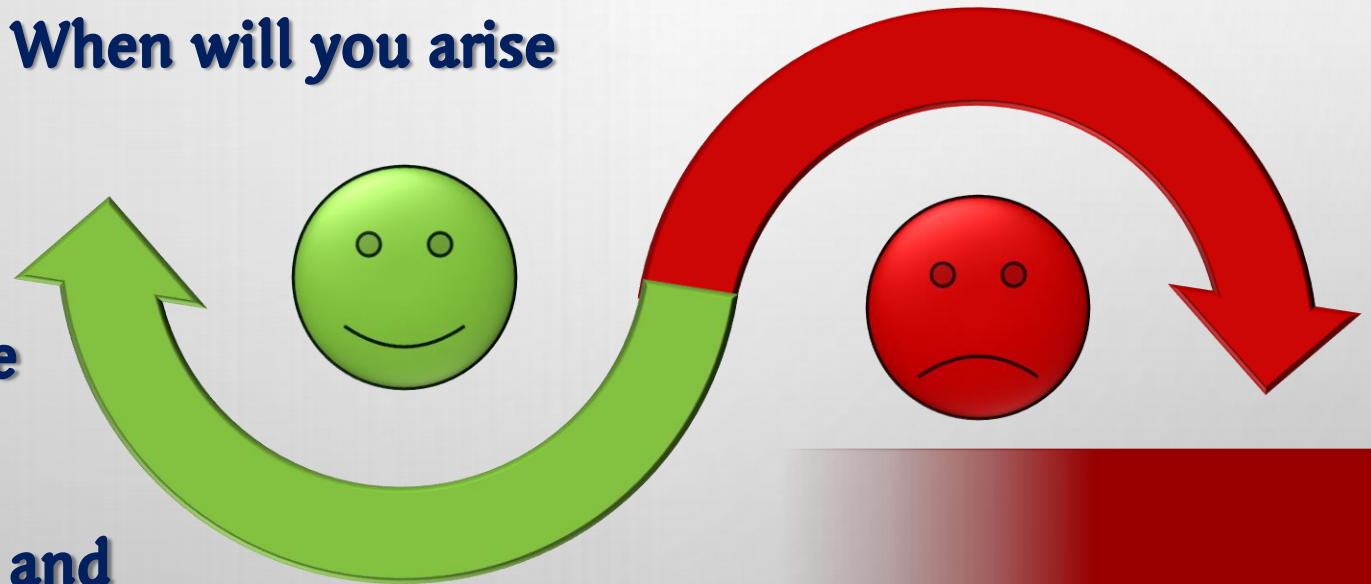
Heb 7: 25 Consequently, he is able to save to

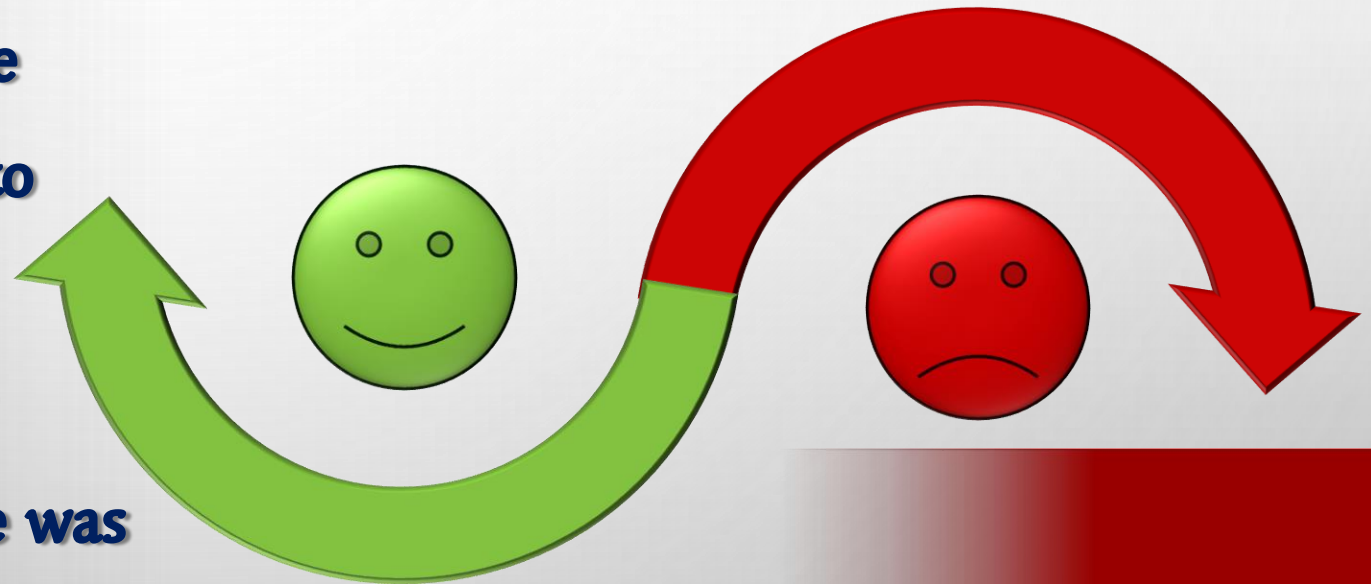
Prov 13:4 The soul of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, while the soul of the diligent is richly supplied.



Consider the Future

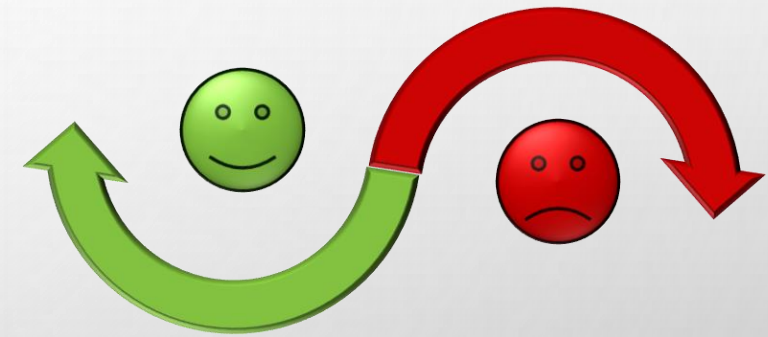


Heb 11: 24-26 By faith Moses, when he was grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to be mistreated with the people of God than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. He considered the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward.

Heb 12:1-6 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so **great a cloud** of witnesses, let us also **lay aside every weight**, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with **endurance** the race that is set before us, **looking to Jesus**, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God .Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted. In your struggle against sin you have not yet **resisted** to the point of shedding your blood. And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, **do not regard lightly** the discipline of the Lord nor be weary when reproved by him. For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives".
