6 ☐ **Day 4: Lights Arranged**

It is assuredly not the creation of the sun, etc. This the inspired historian does not say, but only that God now constituted the heavenly luminaries, after the plants and before the animals for the Adamic earth.  Many positive aspects, but...
 Left first love

14 ☐ **Smyrna**

From about 167 to 313 AD
 Faithfulness maintained through suffering

15 ☐ **Pergamos**

From about 313 to 606 AD (Constantine)
 Maintained "my faith", but...
 Settling down in the world
 Accepting a formal mercenary system ("doctrine of Balaam" and the "doctrine of Nicolaitanes")

16 ☐ **Thyatira**

From about 606 to the present
 Many good works, but...
 Permitting the False Prophetess

17 ☐ **Sardis**

From about 1526 to the present
 Much truth "received" and "heard"
 A recovery of important truth (The Reformation)
 But only a "name" to live, dead otherwise
 Formalism and worldliness

18 ☐ **Philadelphia**

From about 1800 to the present
 The Scriptures opened ("you have kept my Word")
 Recovery of substantial Truth

From about 1900 (!) to the present
 Departure: "they have gone in *the way of Cain*, and given themselves up to *the error of Balaam* for reward, and perished in the *gainsaying of Core*." [Jude 11]

20 ☐ **The Challenge for the Present Day**

2 Tim 3:1 – "But this know, that in the last days difficult times shall be there;"
 Jude 3 -- "contend earnestly for the faith *once delivered* to the saints."
 Rev 3:11 -- "I am coming soon. *Hold fast what you have*, so that no one may seize your crown."

21 ☐ **A Very Brief History of "Plymouth Brethren"**

The early 1800s saw increasing interest in the future of Israel
 18-teens and 1820s the form and character of the assembly began to be realized
 Winter 1827-1828 JN Darby, E Cronin, JG Bellett, and F Hutchinson began breaking bread together.
 1828 first pamphlet published
 1831 named "Plymouth Brethren" assigned
 1848 First division

22 ☐ **Breakup of the Original Company of "Brethren"**

1. In 1827, JN Darby, E Cronin, JG Bellett, and F Hutchinson began to break bread together.
2. In 1848, the first division occurred.
3. Many divisions followed thereafter, fragmenting the original company.

23 ☐ **Final Thoughts: Why this failure?**
