10:15-12:00 Reading I – The Lord Jesus – Anointed Prophet – Heb 1:1, 2;

Definition: **Prophet** – (Heb. nabi, from a root meaning "to bubble forth, as from a fountain," hence "to utter," comp.) A prophet was a spokesman for God; he spoke in God's name and by his authority #Ex 7:1 He is the mouth by which God speaks to men #Jer 1:9 Isa 51:16 and hence what the prophet says is not of man but of God #2Pe 1:20,21 comp. #Heb 3:7 Ac 4:25 Ac 28:25 Prophets were the immediate organs of God for the communication of His mind and will to men #De 18:18,19. The foretelling of future events was not a necessary but only an incidental part of the prophetic office. The great task assigned to the prophets whom God raised up among the people was "to correct moral and religious abuses, to proclaim the great moral and religious truths which are connected with the character of God, and which lie at the foundation of his government." Our Lord is frequently spoken of as a prophet #Lu 13:33 24:19 – He is the Word...

Definition: **Priest** - The Heb. kohen, Gr. hierus, Lat. sacerdos, always denotes one who offers sacrifices. Their duties were manifold #Ex 27:20,21 29:38-44 Le 6:12 10:11 24:8 Nu 10:1-10 #De 17:8-13 33:10 Mal 2:7 They represented the people before God, and offered the various sacrifices prescribed in the law. The priests all prefigured the great Priest who offered "one sacrifice for sins" "once for all"
