- 3. Let's talk about Titus. <u>Do we hear of him in Acts 15?</u>

- 14. <u>Romans</u> deals with the <u>death of Christ</u>, <u>Hebrews</u> with the <u>blood of</u> Christ and Galatians with the cross of Christ. Discuss
- 14. What does *the law* have to do with verse 20?
- 15. How would one "frustrate the grace of God"?

- 1. Verse 1 implies that a <u>person</u> has bewitched them. Discuss
- 2. Discuss the *one thing* he would learn of them in verse 2?
- 3. They had begun "<u>in the Spirit</u>" why now the reference to the "<u>flesh</u>"?
