“My Assembly”

Why should I attend the assembly in our town? There are probably a lot of places that have nicer buildings, more people, a choir, a sports program, a bands, and a host of other activities that are designed to make them attractive – to entertain – and to attract large numbers of people. We feel this is a good year to explore this question with our young people again.

Our exercise this year is to have you leave at the end of this week with a much clearer understanding of what our Lord Jesus was referring to when he said: “I will build my Assembly”. I will ask the question again – “Why go to the assembly” ? What is special about gathering to the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ ? Is there something special about our gathering point being a person and not a place? We feel that it is essential for you to be able to answer these questions! We would like to start at the beginning this week with the first mention of the Church in Matthew and the establishment of the Church as seen in Acts. We would like to take distinct areas up each day with you and build upon the foundation that has been laid in scripture. I will ask some questions to start our discussions.

1. WHERE IS THE CHURCH MENTIONED IN THE OLD TESTAMENT?
2. WHERE IS THE **FIRST** MENTION OF THE CHURCH IN THE NEW TESTAMENT?
 - a. Discuss who this was revealed to and by whom?
 - b. In what *tense* is the building of this Church spoken of?
 - c. Discuss the meaning of the word “*Church*” or “*Assembly*”?
3. WHERE IS THE **SECOND** MENTION OF THE CHURCH IN THE NEW TESTAMENT?
 - a. How *many people* are mentioned?
 - b. *Who* does the gathering?
 - c. What is the significance of the word “*together*”
 - d. Unto *what* are they gathered?
 - e. Discuss the *promise* connected with this gathering.

4. BEFORE GOING INTO ACTS – LET’S DISCUSS 1 CORIN 12-VS 13
 - a. “For by one *Spirit* are we all *baptized* into *one body*.. . .

 - d. A **carnal condition** was OK!

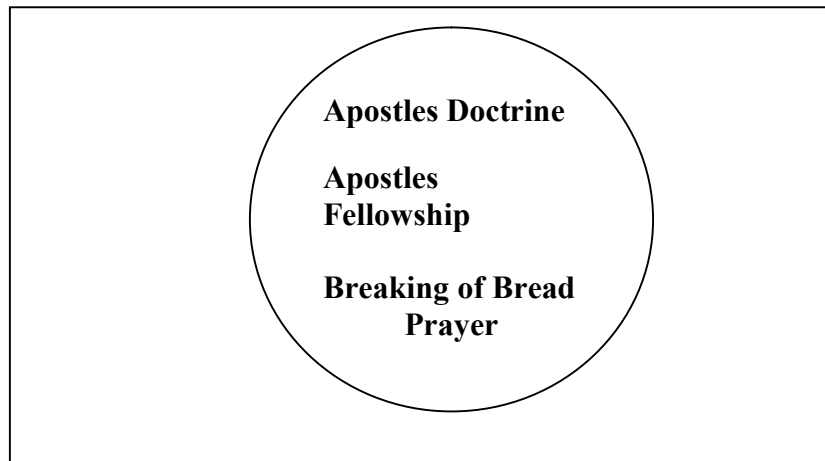
5. LET'S DISCUSS 2ND TIMOTHY 1 – VS 15

 - a. How does verse 15 describe their condition?
 - b. How did **their analysis** of their condition differ from that of the Lord Jesus?
 - c. In this final Church – **where is the Lord Jesus** in relation to that which professes to bear his name?
 - d. What will the end be of this **Christian profession**?

THERE ARE MANY THINGS THAT HAVE NOT CHANGED AND NOW WE WANT TO SPEND TIME ON THEM.

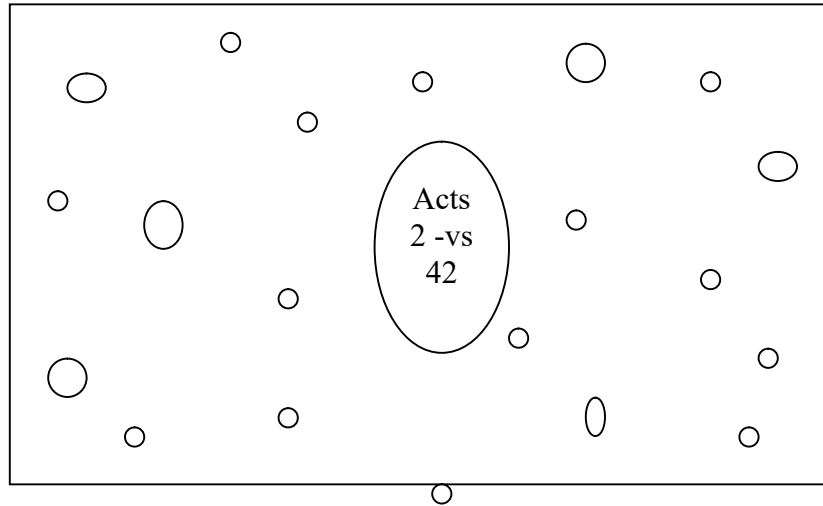
LORD, WHAT WILT THOU HAVE ME TO DO?

1. LET'S TAKE ACTS 2-42 AGAIN AS A STARTING POINT.



The circle represents things as they were and you could see clearly who made up the Church. They were all together and there were no divisions – the Holy Spirit's presence was recognized and the saints were “*continuing stedfastly*”. They expressed this fellowship in the “breaking of bread” and it was sustained by “prayer”.

What has happened to the larger circle? Only one thing! It is smaller. What has caused this? Do you remember the “seeds” that we looked at that had been sown? They have germinated and grown and the effects are seen by the many denominations and sects that have left the original ground of gathering.



Acts 2 – vs 42. Perhaps some wanted to be known by their views on baptism – others on tongues – others liked the rituals of Judaism – others preferred a one-man ministry – still others felt we should be keeping the law – who could begin to give the reasons for all the various denominations that are around us today? Are the ones who have left this original circle still believers? Do they possess gifts from the risen, ascended, head of the Church? Are there souls saved among these saints? Are they going to be taken up in the rapture when Christ comes? The answers to these questions are obviously “yes” and we are not to doubt the sincerity of these believers. BUT – the question for us today is –

WHERE WOULD THE LORD HAVE ME TO BE?

1. THE **“GROUND OF GATHERING”** HAS NOT CHANGED BECAUSE OF THE FAILURE THAT IS AROUND US AND THAT WE ARE A PART OF. WE STILL MEET ON THE GROUND THAT THERE JUST ONE BODY.

EPHESIANS I – VS 11**
